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OUR MISSION *Marguerite's Place, Inc. provides women with children, who are striving to achieve and sustain self-sufficiency, with transitional housing as well as emotional, educational and social support services. Our philosophy is to give a hand up and not a hand out.*



ELIGIBILITY & PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

To receive consideration of acceptance into the programs at Marguerite's Place, you must be a homeless woman between the age of 18 and 45, and have children under the age of twelve.

Women who are struggling with violence, abuse, poverty, or other challenging life circumstances are encouraged to apply.

Applicants must, however, be capable of utilizing the program services provided, live independently, and be willing to change behaviors.

Applicants are expected to:

- Pay service fees and utilities
- Purchase food and prepare meals
- Maintain an apartment
- Participate in educational, training, or employment programs for a minimum of thirty hours per week
- Actively participate in residential meetings and other group activities
- Commit to recovery



PROGRAM SUCCESS

Hundreds of women and children have called Marguerite's Place, Inc. home over the last twenty years. Our success stories include: moms that have gone on to achieve their GEDs, Bachelors, or Masters degrees. Some of our graduates are employed as nurses, LPNs, MAs, dental hygienists or are in other social and human services positions. Approximately 85% of our moms achieve their goals of self-sufficiency.

While at Marguerite's Place, Inc., some of our moms have been the beneficiaries of cars and household items which they may take with them upon graduation at 24 months.

AFTER GRADUATING

Every graduate is eligible to receive support through a five-year 'after-care' program.

Additionally, MP Housing, our sister organization and separate 501(c)(3), owns and maintains 10 condominiums that program graduates may be eligible to rent.

PROGRAM SERVICES

The overall goal of Marguerite's Place is to provide assistance and support to women so they may acquire the necessary skills and tools to assist them in moving forward to self-sufficiency.

We provide:

- Fully-furnished apartments
- On-site, Licensed Plus by the State of NH, childcare for children 6 weeks to pre-school. Our childcare services are open to the public
- Ongoing programs in life skills, including: nutrition, finance, seminars on pertinent issues, comprehensive health management, and much more
- One-on-one parenting and intensive case management
- Assistance in acquiring crucial skills to obtain independence through educational and/or training and
